

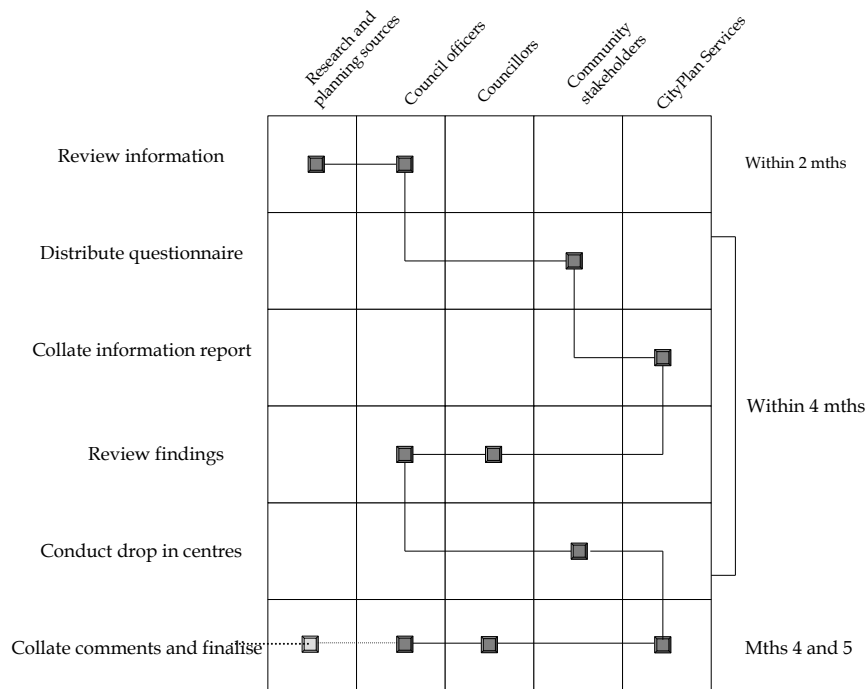
Sequestering the Fed Budget 2022 pre-Process

No Federal Budget has followed the iA and iNSW (Greiner) flow charts and also none have followed my award-winning methodology. Critical failures have been gifting without justification (metros, Parra trans, Inland Rail etc), and absence of

- stakeholder consultation,
- affirmation through audit checks,
- professional economic analyses (as in Council on the Cost of Government, “Economies and Efficiencies of Urban Transport” (RG ©), and
- engineering certifications.

The context problems which require OECD/Treasury Regs - rejected by Morrison, Frydenberg, Kennedy, Chalmers, Baird, Constance, Berejiklian and Perrottet (e.g. his stupid approach to Turnbull who replied “we are not an ATM”) - are in my copyrighted publications which are not available to Chalmers and Kennedy without permission & settlement of whole theft quantum.

The process theoretically flows - and gaps are publicly reported - as in the following chart (the vertical columns show the parties involved while the rows show the activities). Naturally this is simplified for the purposes of illustration. Councillors and Council officers are to be read as PM, Treasurer, Ministers and agency heads:



The following explains this process in more detail and note my publications set out the parallel OECD processes with my interpretations, the time frames apply except that the Albanese Government has lost months due to Kennedy’s mentality:

Contents of each information paper:

- employment, population, traffic, public transport usage, land use, ethnicity, income, education, FSRs, mainstreet
- Good and bad examples of centres, streetscape, public transport terminals etc
- SWOT
- Streetscape characteristics, heritage, environment etc
- Urban form assessment, new urbanism thinking
- Council policies re rating, parking, building and development controls/costs/delays etc – versus reform standards, new thinking etc
- Strategic planning processes, annual reviews, WCC funding flexibility, other governmental contributions etc

It can be seen that the consultation requirement is proposed to be conducted in two stages.

The first is the distribution of a stakeholder survey together with appropriate publicity and enquiry resources, using in part XXX Council's good offices. This will complement desktop research into demographic, land use, DA and other trends. It is important to note that the survey will be supported by an information note based on that desktop research.

The second phase is proposed to be the conduct of drop-in centres in each of the business precincts. This initiative is proposed in the light of experience in other councils, for example in its recent budget consultations Newcastle City Council focussed on drop-in centres which had attracted stronger community involvement. This works well as an explanatory interface as well as a convenient and reliable way for the community to provide feedback. (The 'centres' would probably be tables in the main streets or in shops for up to 2 hours, morning or afternoon, on designated days).
